- Another choice is to get your Medicare benefits by joining a Medicare health plan (such as **Paramount Elite Standard (HMO-POS)**).

Who can join?

To join **Paramount Elite Standard (HMO-POS)**, you must be entitled to Medicare Part A, be enrolled in Medicare Part B, and you must live in our service area. Our service area includes these counties in Indiana: Adams, Allen, DeKalb and Noble.

Our service area includes these counties in Michigan: Branch, Hillsdale, Lenawee, Monroe and Washtenaw. Our service area includes these counties in Ohio: Allen, Ashland, Crawford, Cuyahoga, Defiance, Erie, Fulton, Geauga, Hardin, Henry, Huron, Lake, Lorain, Lucas, Medina, Mercer, Ottawa, Paulding, Portage, Putnam, Sandusky, Seneca, Summit, Van Wert, Wayne, Williams, Wood and Wyandot.

Which doctors, hospitals, and pharmacies can I use?

Paramount Elite Standard (HMO-POS) has a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other providers. If you use any providers that are not in our network, the plan may not pay for these services and items.

You must generally use network pharmacies to fill your prescriptions for covered Part D drugs.

What do we cover?

Like all Medicare health plans, we cover everything that Original Medicare covers – and *more*. Some of the extra benefits are outlined in this booklet.

We cover Part D drugs. In addition, we cover Part B drugs including chemotherapy and some drugs administered by your provider.

How will I determine my drug costs?

Our plan groups each medication into one of five "tiers." You will need to use your formulary to locate what tier your drug is on to determine how much it will cost you. The amount you pay depends on the drug's tier and what stage of the benefit you have reached. Later in this document we discuss the benefit stages that occur: Initial Coverage and Catastrophic Coverage.


Understanding the Benefits

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The Evidence of Coverage (EOC) provides a complete list of all coverage and services. It is important to review plan coverage, costs, and benefits before you enroll. Visit <u>www.paramounthealthcare.com/medicareplans</u> or call 1-833-554-2335 (TTY 711) to view a copy of the EOC.



Review the provider directory (or ask your doctor) to make sure the doctors you see now are in the network. If they are not listed, it means you will likely have to select a new doctor.





Review the formulary to make sure your drugs are covered.

Understanding Important Rules

In addition to your monthly plan premium, you must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium. This premium is normally taken out of your Social Security check each month.


Benefits, premiums and/or copayments/co-insurance may change on January 1, 2025.

Our plan allows you to see providers outside of our network (non-contracted providers). However, while we will pay for certain covered services, the provider must agree to treat you. Except in an emergency or urgent situation, non-contracted providers may deny care. In addition, you will pay a higher co-pay for services received by non-contracted providers.

Except in emergency or urgent situations, we do not cover services by out-of-network providers (doctors who are not listed in the provider directory) unless it is for dental service. While we will pay for covered dental services outside of the network, the provider must agree to treat you. You will pay a higher cost for services received by non-contracted providers.



I understand that I can be enrolled in only one MA plan at a time-and that enrollment in this plan will automatically end my enrollment in another MA plan (exceptions apply for MA PFFS, MA MSA plans).
